Admission Criteria:

Strings Camp is accepting violin, viola, and cello students ages 4-18 of all levels. Audition by video recording is required only for those applying who are not current students of Strings Camp Faculty.

Musical Activities:

All students will participate in orchestra. It is the Torrey Chamber Music Festival tradition that students and faculty perform Side-by-Side in a final concert without a conductor, so students have the opportunity to play alongside distinguished teachers and learn communication and leadership skills. All students will also work in small group settings, where they will cover technique, solo repertoire, musicality, leadership and ensemble skills. Additionally, each student will be assigned a small chamber music ensemble piece (where they are the only person playing their individual part). Tutti orchestra parts will be assigned and distributed in April, and chamber ensemble music will be assigned and distributed in May. Students are required to work on all of their music with a private teacher prior to attending Strings Camp- you will find that the better prepared you are for camp, the more rewarding the musical experience will be!

There are limited opportunities for solo concertos. Any students interested in this must submit an audition video to Strings Camp faculty by May 1.

Strings Camp 2022 will have a faculty of eight world-class performing string artists visiting Torrey from all around the globe! This is an exciting opportunity for students to work with different teachers and learn from a variety of perspectives and experience.

Strings Camp is partially funded by grants and donations in order to keep tuition prices affordable. We don't want cost to be a barrier to anyone participating in Strings Camp, and we have full and partial scholarships available. Scholarship application: must be completed along with video submission of any solo demonstrating current level by May 1.

Travel and Accommodation

Torrey Chamber Music Festival Strings Camp is a day camp and does not provide any overnight accommodations or meals for students or their families. Non-local participants are welcome, with the understanding that they are responsible for travel to Torrey and accommodation in or near Torrey, and students must be with a parent or guardian at all times outside of Strings Camp.
